

Conservation Districts of Iowa 2019 Resolutions Preconference Voting Results

Below are the results of preconference resolution voting for this year. 360 Commissioners voted on these proposed changes to our programs and rules. Any resolution with over 60% approval is considered passed and any with more than 50% no votes is considered failed. Due to a high number of commissioners asking for more information and debate at our annual conference we have eleven resolutions that will be presented and discussed at conference. Please remember that if your district sponsored one of the resolutions to be brought up at conference, one of your commissioners needs to be in attendance to present the resolution during our annual business meeting on Monday morning August 19th. Also, please come prepared with any additional information that might support your resolution during discussion. With eleven resolutions to discuss – debate time will be strictly limited to two minutes per person per motion with a total of ten minutes allowed for each resolution.

Thank you to all the districts and commissioners that participated in the resolution process this year. Resolutions help set our goals at CDI for the coming year and insure we are representing the Soil and Water District Commissioners of Iowa.
