The Conservation Districts of Iowa (CDI) and the State Soil Conservation and Water Quality Committee (SSCWQC) are joint sponsors of the award.

The following criteria shall be used:

1. The accomplishments of the District shall be of recognized community, state, or other significance.
2. The nomination should identify the work of the District in upland watershed treatment program endeavors.
3. The nomination and supporting information should demonstrate the District’s interdisciplinary approach to resource management and the importance of the watershed in relation to community needs. Strong partnerships with local, state, and federal agencies are a plus.
