A. Instructions

- 1. **Complete this form** by typing or neatly handwriting your responses in the spaces provided below.
- 2. **Answer the nine (9) application questions** on separate pages.
 - Your responses must not exceed four (4) single-sided, single-spaced pages, using a minimum 12-point Times New Roman font and 1-inch margins.
- 3. **Attach an official school transcript** that includes your attendance record, GPA, and current class rank.
 - If your school does not provide this information, please have a school official include a note on school letterhead stating that the information is unavailable.
- 4. Attach your ACT, SAT, or other standardized test scores (optional).
- 5. **Include one (1) letter of recommendation** from a teacher, school official, or employer.
 - Please do not submit more than one letter.
- 6. Submit your completed application and all required attachments to the Soil and Water Conservation District (SWCD) office in the county where you reside no later than Friday, February 6, 2026.
 - To find your county SWCD office, visit the <u>USDA Service Center Locator</u> and select your county on the map.
